WHAT DO I NEED IN ORDER TO BE TESTED?

- FREE COVID-19 Testing, no insurance needed
- Open to the public regardless of symptoms
- Children can be tested with parental consent and must be able to complete the test without restraint

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I ARRIVE AT THE TESTING SITE?

- Parking and walk up testing will be in the back of the health department building
- Each individual will be asked to provide their name, date of birth, phone number and current living address

WHAT IS THE TESTING PROCESS?

- This test is a nasopharyngeal swab
- A soft swab will be inserted into your nose to get the necessary sample. This may be slightly uncomfortable; however, the test is quick and should take less than a minute.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I AM TESTED?

- An employee from the Florida Department of Health in Okeechobee County will contact you with your results
- You will be contacted whether your result is positive or negative

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- There are no restrooms available
- No antibody tests will be available
- Keep at least six feet between you and other people
- Cloth masks will be provided
