WHAT DO I NEED IN ORDER TO BE TESTED?

- FREE COVID-19 Testing, no insurance needed
- Open to the public regardless of symptoms
- Children can be tested with parental consent and must be able to complete the test without restraint

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I ARRIVE AT THE TESTING SITE?

- Parking and walk up testing will be in the back of the health department building
- Each individual will be asked to provide their valid driver's license or Florida identification card with their name, date of birth, and current living address along with their cell phone number

WHAT IS THE TESTING PROCESS?

- This test is either an oral or nasal swab, depending on availability
- A soft swab will be inserted into your mouth or nose to get the necessary sample. This may be slightly uncomfortable; however, the test is quick and should take less than a minute

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I AM TESTED?

- Results are expected to be available within about 48 hours
- The Department of Health will contact you with the phone number you provide if your results are negative or positive for contact investigation purposes

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- There are no restrooms available
- No antibody tests will be available
- Please wear face coverings and keep at least six feet between you & others
- Cloth masks will be provided
