- Please enter through the gates on FL Hwy 710. Please arrive no more than 30 minutes prior to your appointment.
- The Department of Health asks anyone planning to arrive for vaccinations to have consent forms printed and completed before coming to the Agri-Civic Center. You must have a new consent form every time you receive a vaccine. **CONSENT FORMS** can be found at online at <http://okeechobee.floridahealth.gov/programs-and-services/covid.html> or may be picked up at the Okeechobee County Public Library.
- Please be prepared for extended wait times in your vehicle during the event.
